




# Nursing Journals for 2018

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Age and Ageing</b></p> 	<p>2001 - present (OVID online)</p> <p><i>Age and Ageing</i> is an international journal publishing refereed original articles and commissioned reviews on geriatric medicine and gerontology. Its range includes research on ageing and clinical, epidemiological, and psychological aspects of later life.</p>
