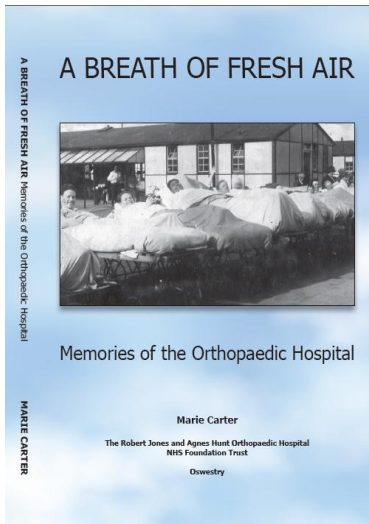


A Breath of Fresh Air Memories of the Orthopaedic Hospital
